Process of Hope

As you heard Al Corbett speak at the congregational meeting, Trinity will be moving forward to explore a new emphasis where Trinity will try to develop a new emphasis where we can proclaim the Gospel in a manner that will engage our community, and especially people who presently do not show an interest in being involved with Church.

The way of doing this is to show that the Gospel inspires us to care about things and people others care about. It is about helping people understand the Gospel is not only proclaimed in a Sunday Worship service, but in it's care for people, the community and the world.

Several people have toyed with ideas where people might share a common interest, be it working to help the elderly or children. Working to make our world more environmentally friendly or using resources to provide grow and provide good food for people who often live on highly processed food.

It might be caring for people who find comfort and joy in the creatures who provide companionship, or moving to be a center where people with needs might find a place of refuge and comfort.

Several considerations we will want to make to help determine the path we might take include things like **Impact**, asking how deeply this might effect individuals or how broadly it might impact the community.

Another consideration is **Engagement**. This means can we engage people with these interests to understand why it is also a matter of faith.

A third consideration is **Evangelical Connectedness**. This simply means that people may be inclined to want explore issues of faith because of their engagement with Trinity's initiative.

Other considerations include **Resources**, meaning what resources will be needed to do this well, which brings us to the consideration about **Partners** we may find who have similar interest concerns and other resources.

Probably one of the most important considerations has to do with **Unanimity**, which simply means will this engage nearly everyone at Trinity.

To move forward we need to engage everyone in the congregation to be a part of this kind of initiative.

It will begin with a process which will just invite us to throw out our ideas, and down the road with will measure how those ideas might meet the goals for the congregation.

Down the road, we will have to do research and planning and find ways to engage everyone in this work.

Watch and listen for plans that will begin as soon as January to begin a process of discernment, prayer, brainstorming and working together.
